



Selecting of a New Name or Using Your Baptismal Name: Saint Name

The renewal of the baptismal promises expresses the intimate connection between Baptism and Confirmation, which the Second Vatican Council stressed. To reflect this connection, Confirmation Candidate's should be encouraged to use their baptismal name. Although it has become common practice to select a 'Confirmation name', neither the Order of Confirmation nor the Code of Canon Law prescribe the selection of a new name. The practice of selecting a patron saint is a worthy practice and may continue.
